Cell Phone/Electronic Devices

Cell phones/electronic devises are a disruption to the educational process. <u>If parents need to forward a message to their child during the school day, please contact the office.</u> When ill, students must see the nurse, who will contact the parents. <u>Students are not allowed to contact their parents via their cell phones.</u>

Students are not permitted to use nor possess cell phones/electronic devises during the school day. All devices should remain in locker. Devices that are in sight, ring or vibrate during the school day will be confiscated. Refusal to hand over the device will be an automatic suspension.

1st V	iolation –	The cell phone is confiscated and turned into the office. Phone will be returned – dismissal. It is the responsibility of the child to notify parents after the first violation.
2 nd V	iolation -	The cell phone is confiscated and turned into the office. <u>Student will be assigned after school detention</u> . Parent/Guardian will be contacted to pick up the phone. Phone will be returned to <u>Parent/Guardian ONLY</u> .
3 rd Vi	iolation-	The cell phone is confiscated and turned into the office. Student will be assigned Saturday Detention Parent/Guardian will be contacted to pick up the phone. Phone will be returned to Parent/Guardian ONLY.
4 th Vi		The cell phone is confiscated and turned into the office. <u>Student will be assigned one (1) day of Reflection Room.</u> Phone <u>WILL NOT</u> be returned until Parent/Guardian and student meet with Administration.
5 th Vi	olation	Future violations will result in suspension from school.
