Kindness Club

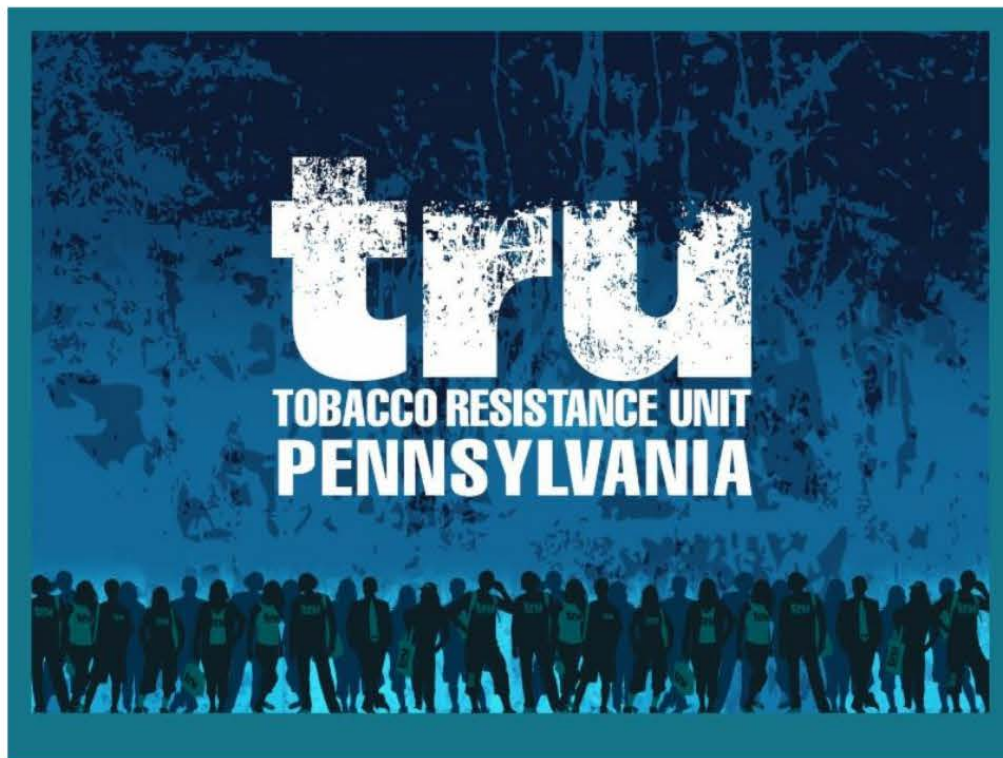

AS A STATEWIDE MOVEMENT, TRU IS FUNDED BY A GRANT THROUGH THE PENNSYLVANIA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MANAGED BY THE PENNSYLVANIA ALLIANCE TO CONTROL TOBACCO (PACT) AND THE AMERICAN LUNG ASSOCIATION.

OUR MISSION WITH TRU IS TO PROTECT OUR STUDENTS FROM ALL TOBACCO PRODUCTS THROUGH COMMUNITY OUTREACH, EDUCATION, PREVENTION, AND CESSATION ACTIVITIES. WE PLAN TO EDUCATE OUR STUDENTS ABOUT THE DANGERS OF TOBACCO AND NICOTINE ADDICTION, ATTAIN AND DEVELOP LEADERSHIP SKILLS, GAIN VOLUNTEER HOURS THAT BENEFIT STUDENTS PERSONALLY AND PROFESSIONALLY, CULTIVATE A POSITIVE, PURPOSEFUL IDENTITY, CONNECT WITH YOUTH FROM AROUND THE STATE WHO HAVE SIMILAR INTERESTS AND AMBITIONS, AND PLAY AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN KEEPING PENNSYLVANIA TOBACCO-FREE.

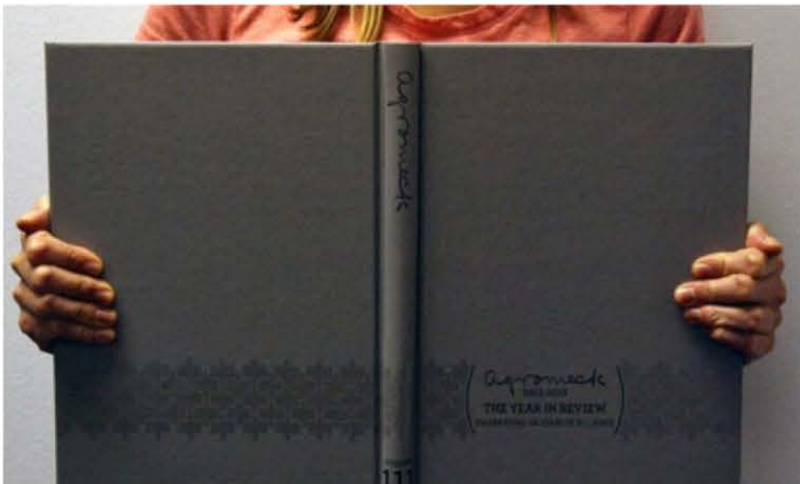

Student Council

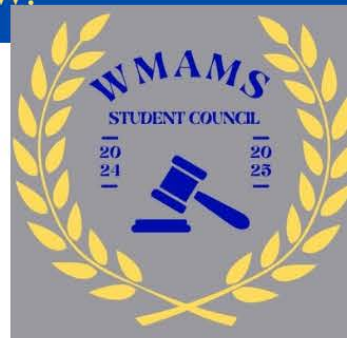
