Dear Parent/Guardian:

Both federal and state laws require that school districts provide military recruiter's access to secondary school students. The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal year 2002, and Pennsylvania Act 10 (The Armed Forces Recruiting Act) reflect these requirements.

School districts are required to provide names, addresses, and telephone listings of junior and senior year students to military recruiters, when requested, unless a parent has "opted out" of providing such information. Military recruiters are entitled to request and receive these lists throughout the year.
